**Crystal River Preserve State Park** maintains upland, freshwater and coastal habitats, for a natural experience, on 27,000 acres.



**Crystal River Archaeological State Park** is an imposing pre-Columbian ceremonial mound complex overlooking the Crystal River. It was designated a National Historic Landmark in 1990.

**Yulee Sugar Mill Ruins Historic State Park** is one of Florida's most evocative historic settings of the Civil War Era. It is the oldest standing historic structure in Citrus County and is partially restored. The mill is listed on the National Historic Register.
