



Crystal River Archaeological State Park. 3400 North Museum Pointe. Located on Museum Pointe in Crystal River, Drive north to State Park Street turn right and take the first right onto Museum Pointe. A National Historic Landmark, this 61-acre, pre-Columbian, Native American site has burial mounds, temple/platform mounds, a plaza area, and a substantial midden. The six-mound complex is one of the longest continuously occupied sites in Florida. As part of the Great Florida Birding Trail, the park offers bird-watchers the chance to observe a variety of birds. The park has a boat tour of the river every Friday, weather permitting.
