



Dixie Shores Trail. Parking is on the outbound side of the road. This area transitions from a ruderal area, through scrubby flatwoods to high marsh of salt grass, cordgrass and needlerush. A trip across the marsh (trail goes through a few inches of water) takes walkers to a marsh island with beautiful marsh hammock and scrubby flatwoods habitat. This is a Great Florida Birding Trail site.

Chickadees, gnatcatchers, flycatchers and towhees are among songbirds that can be seen here.
