



**Ecowalk.** Corner of Curtis Tool Road and Tallahassee Rd. Take the first left off State Park Street before returning to US 19. Drive north for approximately 2.0 miles. The Ecowalk entrance and parking area is on your left. This two mile trail winds through pasture and marsh with remnants of flatwoods and hammock present. Many interpretive signs describing natural features of this area are interspersed along the trail. This is a Great Florida Birding Trail site and kestrels, swallow tailed kites, and other open area birds are seen there. Morning walkers will be treated to the call of the bobwhite quail in the spring and summer months.
